Looking At The Eldership? (2)

When one considers becoming an Elder one must look at all the qualifications that are found in the New Testament. There are many that jump right out at us [able to teach, husband of one wife, etc.] but there are a few that often go overlooked and that are just as essential for one to be qualified as an Elder.

Found in 1 Timothy 3:3, Titus 1:7, "not to be greedy of filthy lucre" is a term that is often overlooked. We are blessed to be a part of a congregation that has within its borders, men who are interested in writing books that will help us to understand God's Book. D.C. Mock's "Leadership That Works," offers good insight toward understanding this qualification.

This qualification refers to how a person views his financial affairs. The ASV translates this phrase: "no lover of money." If a person is greedy for money, he or she will usually have a selfish attitude toward God and others. This is something that all must evaluate for themselves. A realization of this may be overlooked. There seems to be different levels of greediness, which may or may not be apparent. Some have distorted attitudes about needs and wants. Wants usually will cause one to focus on one's self rather than those in need. When one is greedy, he or she will have many other problems, such as dishonesty. "For the love of money is the root of all evil" (1 Timothy 6:10). Everyone should realize that everything we have belongs to God (1 Peter 3:10-12). An elder should be generous in giving. Others may be watching and following his example. Although it is not what others think or see, God knows the heart. If we try to impress others with our giving, do we impress God? He knows what we think and do. Elders are often in a position where a lot of money is involved. This can create an unhealthy situation where some might question one's integrity. If an elder meets this qualification, his integrity will not be in question. Do you want to trust your elders? (page 20)

Since one who is greedy of filthy lucre does not meet the qualification that prohibits this he cannot and should not seek the office of an elder. One who would do so is not honest with himself or with God. We trust the elders to administer the funds that are given on the first day of the week. How could we trust a greedy man?
