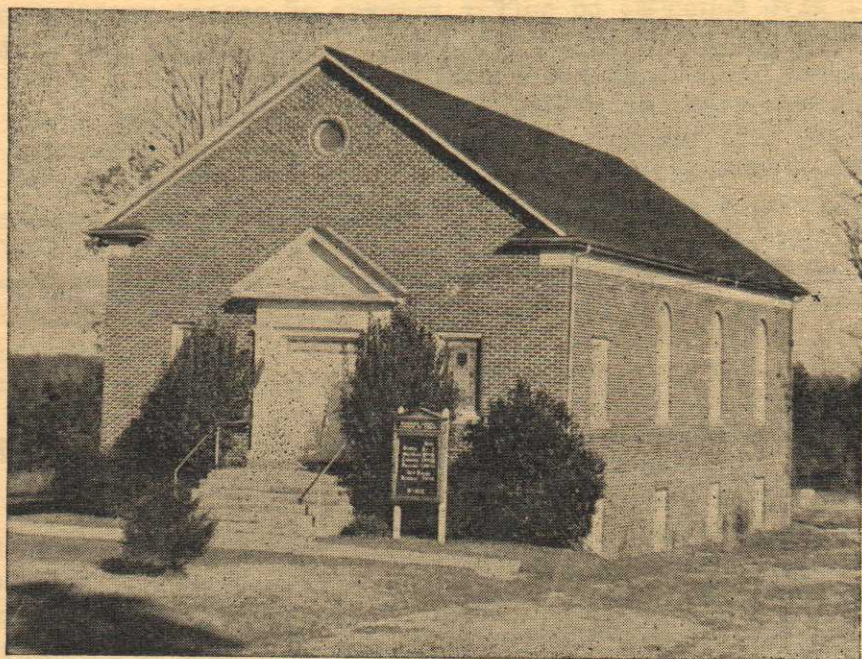

Church Worship John 4:19-24.

Let us consider the five kinds of worship mentioned in the New Testament: First, vain--"But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men." Matt. 15:9. Second, ignorant--"For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, him I declare unto you." Acts 17:23. Third, will-worship--"Which things have indeed a shew of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body; not in any honor to the satisfying of the flesh." Col. 2:23. Fourth, Mock-worship--"and they smote him on the head with a reed, and did spit upon him, and bowing their knees worshipped him. And when they had mocked him they took off the purple from him, and put his own clothes on him, and led him out to crucify him." Mark 15:19, 20. Fifth, true worship--"God is a spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth." Jno. 4:24. Upon what day of the week should the church meet for worship? "And upon the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul preached unto them, ready to depart on the morrow; and continued his speech until midnight." Acts 20:7. Also, 1 Cor. 16:2. Why upon that day? "Now when Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils." Mark 16:9. "Then the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, came Jesus and stood in the midst, and saith unto them, Peace be unto you." Jno. 20:19. "I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice as of a trumpet" Rev. 1:10. We, as Christians, are commanded: "Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching." Heb. 10:25. Too, we are taught what to do in the worship on the Lord's Day, and one part of worship is just as important as another, if it



is to be pleasing unto God. Teach: "Now, brethren, if I come unto you speaking with tongues, what shall I profit you, except I shall speak to you either by revelation, of by knowledge, of by prophesying, or by doctrine" 1 Cor. 14:6, and verse 19: "Yet in the church I had rather speak five words with understanding, than by my voice I might teach others also, than ten thousand words in an unknown tongue." Pray. "Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching the same with all perseverance and supplication for all saints." Eph. 6:18. "Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God." Phil. 4:6. Sing. "Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord." Eph. 5:19. "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord." Col. 3:16. Eat the Lord's Supper. "The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ?" 1 Cor. 10:16. Also, Acts 20:7. Contribute "Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God has prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come." 1 Cor 16:2. Jesus had said this to say about the place for true worship: "For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them" Matt. 18:20. "Ye worship that which ye know not: what we worship: for salvation cometh from the Jews. But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth." Jno. 4:21-24.
