THE POSSIBILITY OF APOSTASY

One of the most popular doctrines in the denominational world today is "once in grace, always in grace". If anything is plainly taught in the Bible, it is the truth on this subject. Consider these verses of scriptures

James 5:19- "Brethren, if any of you do err from the truth..." This very verse shows the possibility of apostasy. James is writing to Christians and says, "if any of you (brethren) do err from the truth". Is it possible for a child of God to fall from grace? James, an inspired man, said so!

I Tim. 5:15- "For some have already turned aside after Satan." Paul here tells of some who were, at one time, following Christ, but have turned from that and followed Satan.

Gal. 5:4- "Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace." Paul told the church at Galatia that if they went back to the old law, they were "fallen from grace"

I Tim. 4:1- "Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith." Nothing could be more positive. Paul said, "the (Holy) Spirit speaketh expressly (clearly; plainly)... some shall depart from the faith."
