“THE VALUE OF A FRIEND”

In Mark 6:7-13 we read of Jesus sending out the twelve and sending them out two by two. He gave them power over unclean spirits. He gave them further specific instructions and then sent them out to preach repentance. They cast out many demons, comforted many people and healed them.

*It is interesting to note that they were sent out in twos. There is a principle found in two working together. Consider Ecclesiastes 4:9-12. **“Two are better than one because they have a good reward for their labor.”** (vs.9), that is often called “accomplishment. **“... for if they fall, one will lift up his companion,”** that would be called “encouragement. **“... but woe to him who is alone when he falls; for he has no one to help him up. (vs.10) Again, if two lie down together they will keep warm; but how can one be warm alone?”**(vs.11). That shows that two can help each other “survive.” **“Though one may be overpowered by another; two can withstand him. And a threefold cord is not quickly broken.”**(vs.12) Two can find great strength together.*

Acts 2:42 describes the first century church as doing and sharing in a way that shows accomplishment, encouragement, survival and great strength. They did things together. We know how great friends can be. We need to consider and experience the value of Christian friends and see what we can do together.

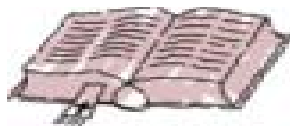

It was announced last Lord's Day that Paul Sinnatuah's sister had passed away recently. Please remember Paul and his family in your prayers.

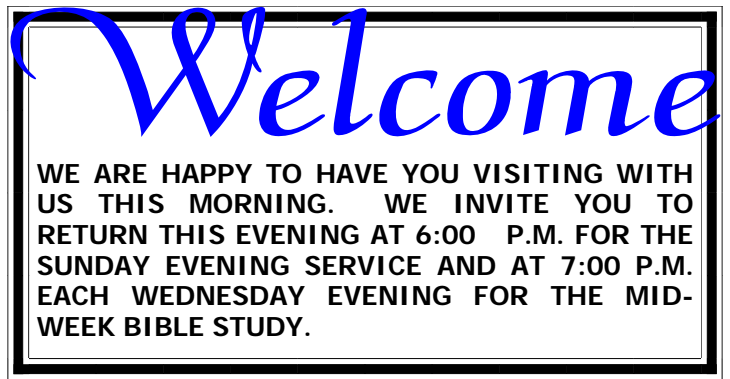
~IN SYMPATHY~
