SERMON ON THE MOUNT (II)

"Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt hath lost its savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast our and to be trodden under the foot of man. Ye are the light of the world..... Let your light so shine before men that they may see your good works and glorify your Father which is in heaven." Matthew 5:13, 14, 16

In the sermon on the mount, Jesus sets forth some of the principals guiding Christianity. In these verses the Lord sets forth some facts about His disciples.

"Ye are the salt of the earth." Salt is a substance which preserves food and gives savor and relish to it. A Christian is to be one who, by his earnest labors, is to preserve the cause of Christ on the earth; as well as to make it seem a wonderful and desirable thing to others. If a child of God loses this kind of action and influence, he is "good for nothing, but to be cast out and to be trodden under the foot of man."

"Ye are the light of the world." About the most appreciated thing in the world is a light in a pitch-dark room. If we live as we should, our lives will be as beacons, leading people away from darkness and destruction unto the Lord. All have some influence over others. It ought, therefore, to be a good and saving influence. Paul said, "Ye are our epistle (letter) written in our hearts, known and read of all men". (II Cor. 3:2) We should be aware that others are noticing our lives and mold them accordingly.

The object of the Christian's life is to let men "see your good works and glorify your Father...in heaven."
