"BIG ROCKS"

One day an expert in time management was speaking to a group of business students and to drive home a point, used an illustration the students would never forget. As he stood in front of the group of high-powered overachievers he said, "Okay, time for a quiz." He then pulled out a one-gallon, wide mouthed Mason Jar and placed it on the table in front of him.

"Good," he replied, he reached under the table and brought out a bucket of sand. He started dumping the sand in the jar and it went into all the spaces left between the rocks and gravel. Once more he asked the question, "Is the jar full?" "No," the class answered.

Then he grabbed a pitcher of water and began to pour it in until the jar was filled to the brim. He looked at the class and asked, "What is the point of this illustration?" One eager student raised his hand and said, "The point is, no matter how full your schedule is, if you try really hard you can always fit some more things in."

"No," the speaker replied. "That's not the point. The truth this illustration teaches us is that if you don't put the big rocks in first, you'll never get them in at all." If the sand, gravel, and water had been placed in the jar first, then the larger rocks would have never fit."
