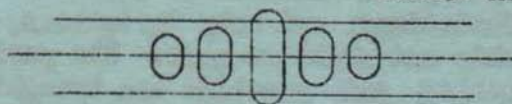
SERMONS FOR SUNDAY

Sunday Morning at the 11:00 o'clock service the Sermon topic will be "THE CHRISTIAN SACRIFICE".

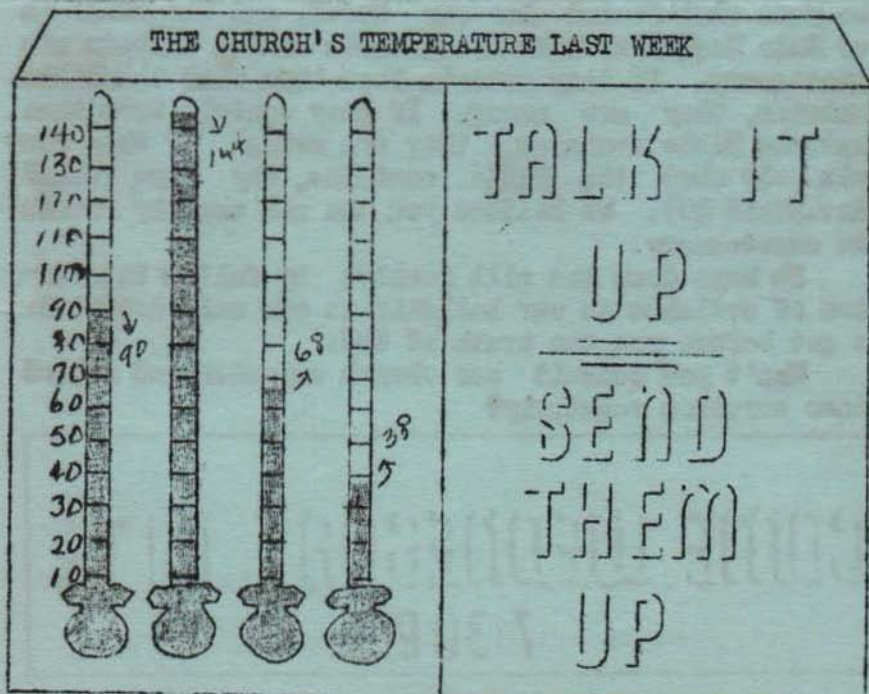
At the evening service which begins at 7:00 P.M. the lesson will be "AN OBEDIENT PAUL".
