Zambia School of Biblical Studies

Last week we talked about the Zambia School of Biblical Studies' latest 15 graduates. This week we want to share information about how the ZSOBS has helped to spread the gospel in Africa. One example is the East African School of Biblical Studies in Uganda. The school was started in March, 2003. It is operated by **two graduates of the ZSOBS**. It has graduated 47 men as of June, 2016. The six men who graduated in June have been involved in establishing six(6) new congregations in the past year in the area around the school

One congregation is worshiping at the school with 19 baptized members. The people in Uganda seem to be very receptive to the gospel of Jesus Christ. The school in Uganda has just completed a new building that will allow them to accept 20 students for the next intake of students. These 6 graduates will go out and join the 41 other graduates of this school to preach the gospel, start new congregations and try to restore erroring congregations. Warners does not financially help the school in Busia, Uganda, but Jerry Sullins is the state-side Supervisor of this school.

Another example is The Ghana School of Preaching (West Africa). It is in its 7th intake of students. The school is operated by 3 of the Zambia graduates. Since its beginning, almost 15 years ago, 58 have graduated and all have been place in local congregations throughout Ghana. Jerry's son, Ray Sullins, works with this school.

Graduates of the Zambia School are teaching in at least 6 other preacher schools in African countries. This is exactly what our Lord told Timothy to write in 2 Timothy 2:2: "And the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also."

Each member at Warners has had a part in this great work through our contributions and prayers. Only eternity will reveal the souls that will be in heaven as a result of our combined efforts in this and other good works we support.
