THE OCCULT: SUPERSTITION

Superstition, as defined by Webster, is "A belief or practice resulting from ignorance, fear of the unknown." Let's first look at some examples of superstition. We will then look as some causes of superstition, reasons why some turn to superstition and the truth concerning superstition.

Some examples of what we might call Good luck: #7, wishing wells, wish bones, rabbits' foot, horseshoes, four-leaf-clovers, ball players rally hats, etc.

Some examples of what we might call Bad luck: #13, walking under a ladder, breaking a mirror, black cats, wedding rituals, etc.

Some reasons why some turn to some form of superstition are ignorance, (Jn. 8:32] and fear (1 Sam. 5:2-5]. An estimated 20 million Americans use charms of some sort. Many religious people believe in patron saints that intervene, e.g., St. Christopher medals are believed to provide safety to the wearer.

The truth is, superstition is opposed to sound doctrine and truth (Titus 2:1, 7). Those who promote these occult ways are enticing one to believe a lie (2 Co. 2:11; Eph. 5:6). There is no such thing as luck or unjust favor shown to an individual (Mt. 5:45; Acts 10:34-35). The Gospel will make us free from fear (Rom. 8:15)(Phil. 4:6).
