SCRIPTURES.

1. Titles.

But his delight is in the law of the Lord. Psm. 1:2.

Seek ye out of the book of the Lord, and read. Isa. 34:16.

Which he hath promised afore by his prophets in the holy scriptures. Rom. 1:2.

And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. Eph. 6:17.

Holding forth the word of life. Phil. 2:16.

2. The Sword of the Spirit.

And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. Eph. 6:17.

For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. Heb. 4:12.

3. Divinely Inspired.

All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness. 2 Tim. 3:16.

Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man; but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost. 2 Pet. 1:20, 21

4. Reading and Exposition of the Scriptures.

So they read in the book in the law of God distinctly and gave the sense, and caused them to understand the reading. Neh. 8:8.

Therefore go thou, and read in the roll, which thou hast written from my mouth, the words, of the Lord in the ears of the people in the Lord's house upon the fasting day; and also thou shalt read them in the ears of all Judah that come out of their cities. Jer. 36:6.

I charge you by the Lord that this epistle be read unto all the holy brethren. 1 Thess. 5:27.

5. Instraction of Children.

And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. 2 Tim. 3:15.

6. To be Intelligently Examined.

These were more honourable than those in Thessalonica in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether these things were so. Acts .7:11.

Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. 2 Tim. 2:16.

7. Fulfilled by Christ.

Think not that I am come to destroy the law and the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfill. Matt. 5:17.

8. As Regarded by the True Believer.

But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. Psm. 1:2.

The law of the Lord is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple. Psm. 19:7.

The law of thy mouth is better unto me than thousands of gold and silver. O how love I thy law! it is my meditation all the day. How sweet are thy words unto my taste! yea, sweeter than honey to my mouth! Psm. 119: 72, 97, 103.

9. Not subject to Change.

Ye shall not add to the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the Lord your God which I command you. Deut. 4: 2.

For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled. Matt. 5:18.

For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: and if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part ^{out} of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book. Rev. 18, 19.

10. The Basis of Judgment.

He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge in the last day. John 12:48.
