## BEING THANKFUL

Corrie Ten Boom wrote a book entitled, The Hiding Place. This book spoke of how she and her family had been hiding Jews from the Nazis during World War II. Eventually the Nazis' figured out what this Dutch family was doing, arrested, and imprisoned them. Corrie Ten Boom's sister frequently thanked God during their imprisonment and encouraged Corrie to do the same. On one occasion, they had been moved to a new prison camp and placed in overcrowded quarters that were overrun by fleas. Corrie told her sister she would not thank God for the fleas, but her sister insisted that she thank God even for the fleas. Later on the Ten Boom sisters discovered that none of the German guards would enter their quarters because of the fleas, and this gave them some freedom and rest from their captors. Upon discovering this fact, Corrie decided to thank God even for the fleas.

Jesus was passing through Samaria on His way from Galilee to Jerusalem when He was met with ten lepers (Luke 17:11-19). They stood at some distance from Him as they cried out for mercy. Jesus told them to go and show themselves to the priests. On their way to the priests they were cleansed of their leprosy. Of the ten lepers that were cleansed, one returned to Jesus to thank Him. The one that returned was a Samaritan. Jesus said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine? Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" (Luke 17:17-18).

The Psalmist wrote, "Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever. Oh, give thanks to the Lord of lords! For His mercy endures forever."

(Psalm 136:1-3). The author of the 136<sup>th</sup> Psalm then proceeded to specifically mention a number of blessings provided by God for which he was thankful. Then he ends the Psalm by saying, “Oh, give thanks to the God of heaven! For His mercy endures forever.” (Psalm 136:26)

Daniel’s life was threatened by a new decree requiring all requests be made of the king and none other. The law made it illegal for Daniel to pray to God under penalty of death in a den of lions. At the risk of a violent and painful death, Daniel continued to pray to God, even giving thanks to God as his custom was since early days.” (Daniel 6:10)

We should give thanks to God for the victory we have in Christ. (1 Corinthians 15:57). We should be thankful for the indescribable gift of His Son. (2 Corinthians 9:15) We can give thanks for our brethren (Ephesians 1:16). We can rejoice and give thanks for an number of tremendous blessings God has given to us. (Philippians 4:4-7; 2 Thessalonians 5:16-18).
