CAUSE OF DEATH

No hatred, bitterness, or meanness is intended by this article. The intent is simply a recognition and affirmation of the unique and precious value of each person. Ourworldindata.org reports the number of people killed by natural disasters in this world is around 60,000/year. Reason.org reported research findings related to mortality rates for extreme weather events over a 111-year period. The data shows mortality rates from natural disasters have decreased by over 90% since 1920. Death rates from droughts have decreased 99.9% since the 1920's, death rates from floods have decreased 98% since the 1930's, and death rates from storms have decreased 55% since the 1970's. The reality is that far less people are dying from natural disasters now than were dying from the same causes one hundred years ago. But even with the decrease in mortality rates from natural disasters, we mourn the loss of life that occurs in such terrible and tragic circumstances. In fact, the loss of even one life in a disaster should be considered tragic.

Let's take the number of 60,000 deaths per year caused by natural disasters and compare it to the number of deaths each year that are caused by abortions. NOW.org (National Organization of Women) is by no means a conservative resource. Yet, they report a number of 42 million abortions world-wide globally based on a 2003 World Health Organization (WHO) Report. Guttmacher.org reports approximately 56 million abortions globally each year based on data from about 125,000 abortions each day. In 2018, they reported 42 million abortions. Worldometers collects data from the WHO as well as various government resources, and scientific journals.

Based on the lower numbers reported for 2003 by NOW, and the number reported by Worldometers for 2018, we can fairly say there are about 42 million people killed each year by practice of abortion. Compare that to the 60,000 killed by natural disasters each year. In fact, let's compare the <u>daily</u> number of world-wide abortions to the <u>annual</u> number killed by natural disasters. Using Worldometers number that would be 125,000 people killed by abortions <u>each</u> day as compared to 60,000 people killed by natural disasters <u>each year</u>. Here is another way to say it: There are twice as many killed by abortions per day as are killed by natural disasters per year.

The number of mothers killed in the process of abortion globally should also be considered. Both Lancet.com and Abort73.com report findings from a 2014 research study funded by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation. The data showed from about 38,000 to 49,000 women are killed globally each year by the abortion procedure. NOW reports a number of 78,000 women killed in abortion procedures each year. Compare that number to the 60,000 each year who die by natural disaster. This is a great tragedy. But, even if we take the lowest number of 38,000 mothers killed by abortion, we have a tremendous tragedy. Those with no respect for the life of the baby might say decrease the number by making abortions safer. Those who love life, whether born or unborn say decrease, or eliminate the number of mothers being killed by this process by stopping the practice. There are no mothers killed by abortions if there are no abortions.

The tragedy of lives lost in abortion is recognized by all Biblical passages that speak of the sin of murder (Galatians 5:16-26). We must value the lives of the mothers lost in abortion procedures, as well as the lives of the children killed by abortion. We must see in abortions a tremendous human tragedy. We must value and love the souls of the mothers who have aborted their babies and we must show them the love and grace of a forgiving God. We must love and value the souls of the abortion doctors, and we must hope that they too will come to know the love and grace of the forgiving God.
