On October 20th and 21st Warners Chapel will be hosting a Financial Seminar sponsored by Freed-Hardeman University. On Saturday morning there will be a ½ day seminar led by brother Kyle Lamb. Kyle is a native of Southern Indiana and graduated from Freed-Hardeman University with business finance degree in 2000 and an MBA in 2011. He is a Certified Financial Planner and has spent most of his career specializing in providing financial planning services to alumni and friends of Freed-Hardeman University. He also spent two years working as a financial advisor for a large brokerage firm. He is currently the Assistant Vice-President for Regional Development at Freed-Hardeman University, where he leads the office in structuring financial planning techniques and strategies to meet the needs and desires of donors, alumni and friends of the university.

In Genesis 22:14, we read, "14 And Abraham called the name of the place, The-Lord-Will-Provide; as it is said *to* this day, "In the Mount of the Lord it shall be provided." (NKJV). In this passage, God is spoken of as "Jehovia-jireh," which means the Lord will provide. We know the Lord will provide, but we do not know how He will provide.

The following questions are helpful in discovering how the Lord provides:

- 1. What are some surprising ways the Lord has provided for your needs?
- 2. Did the Lord provide exactly what you wanted or what you needed?
- 3. Have you had to wait on something you wanted?

When you received what you *needed* instead of what you wanted, did you have what you really wanted after all? God did not provide all the necessary resources for David to be king all at once. David received what he needed when he needed it. We must ask for God's help with the needs of our lives and not expect wants and desires to be fulfilled.
