More than 2.5 million people die in the U.S. each year. Their passing will lead to months of grieving by millions of family and friends. To some it will be a tragedy that will complicate and devastate their lives for years to come.

Only God knows how many of those people will wind up in a state of eternal separation from him, and eternal condemnation as well. Of the number mentioned before, how many do you think will make it to Heaven? Jesus says, "Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it."
