CHARLOTTE:

A North Carolina man has been sentenced to nearly three decades in prison in the beating death of his 83-year-old mother.

The Charlotte Observer reported that 56-year-old Jerry Heath was sentenced to 27 years in prison after pleading guilty Thursday to second-degree murder.

Authorities say Heath killed his mother over \$35. Prosecutors say Jerry Heath hit Annie Heath with a lamp in November after she refused to give him more money. The Charlotte man wept as his relatives told a judge they weren't mad at Heath.

His attorney says Heath had been drinking and smoking crack the night of the killing.

Someone will say, "Well, it is obvious that he never planned to kill his mother." But if he had not been consuming alcohol and crack cocaine he would never have put himself in that position! If I know that the Australian Brown snake can take my life, there is no way I want to be anywhere near it. That should be our approach to substance abuse because it is a deadly poison!
