Fellow Workers in Panama and Nicaragua

In the adult Bible class this past Sunday we talked about 3rd John, specifically verses 3-8 and the idea of being fellow workers for the truth through the financial support of others. It brought to mind the work that Warners Chapel supports in various places such as Panama and Nicaragua. Money that is given to support these works allows us to be fellow workers for the cause of Christ in those places. Great work is occurring in Panama where Warners Chapel helps to support Alfonso Smith. Alfonso works with several congregations in Panama, often traveling by boat to the various islands. Below is his latest report and while Alfonso's written word is not perfect English you definitely can see the good that is taking place and his thanks for our support as fellow workers in Christ.

"I would like to greet all the brothers and sisters in the United States specially does who suport the workin in Bocas del Toro, Panama. we are reporting 6 new members of the church 2 baptizim in Solarte, 1 in Bocas, 1 in Bahia Honda 2 in Kusapin. we are doing some repairing and remodalations and the building in Bocas, in the firste week in march I was invited to teach a seminar in Darien the issue was about the holy spirit we had 4 baptizims as result of the seminar in april 16-19 we wild have a gospel campaing in the village of bahia azul and in september in cusapin for the campaing in Bahia Azul will rent 4 boats plus 160 gallons of gasoline we need your help to buy 40 bibles at \$8.00 price. thanks to the church at east ridge Warnel Chapel and Sody for you great help in supporting the work in bocas. May the Lord bless you always"

Similarly, in just 5 weeks, a group from Warners Chapel will be going to El Rama, Nicaragua, for the annual medical/evangelism campaign. Over 2000 people will be seen by medical professionals. Another 200 or more will have individual Bible studies conducted by a team of Americans, native preachers and translators. From this we expect to have 20-25 baptisms. Everyone from Warners Chapel is not able to go to Nicaragua but you can also be a fellow worker for the cause of Christ with your financial support. Our financial status (as of 4/28) for the trip is as follows.

Total cost of the flight, in-country expenses, and 2nd bag of supplies: \$17,989.80

Total from treasury, participant deposits, extra member contributions: \$12,284.00

Balance remaining: \$5,705.80

With this balance, each participant will owe an additional \$475.48. Each one has already paid a \$300 deposit and is responsible for shots, malaria pills, passport fees, service tips, customs fees, lunches and some other meals not covered by the in-country expense.

If you can help financially above your regular contribution, please make your check out to Warners Chapel and use one of the envelopes marked "Nicaragua" on the desk in the foyer. If you can't help financially, your prayers are solicited for a safe and productive trip.
