The Van and New Bus

As we discussed in our congregational meeting, the National Transportation Safety Board has issued a number of safety warning bulletins concerning our passenger van. There have been numerous accidents and fatalities in these vans due to a higher frequency of roll over and when there is a rollover the side panels were not constructed strong enough to hold up. It was made for a work van, not a passenger van. Some church insurance companies are dropping coverage for these vans or requiring the removal of seats so that it cannot fit 15 people. Because we are concerned and the potential for our insurance company to drop coverage, we are selling the van. To replace the van we are in the process of purchasing a new 15 passenger bus. The bus is easy to step into, you can fully stand up in it, it has individual wide seats with seatbelts and plenty of storage as well. It will have Warners Chapel signage too. Obviously this is a huge benefit to the congregation and we believe we can get more participation in local evangelism and local mission efforts and participation in area gospel meetings and it can better serve our seniors and youth as well.

We thank the Jim and Gladys Harper estate for providing 100% of the funds to fully purchase the new bus. We should have delivery in about 30 days. We are also looking into putting up a carport to keep it covered.

As for the van, while we have a tentative buyer, we do want to offer the option to purchase it to any member of the congregation through a sealed bid process. If you are interested please submit your name and bid in a sealed envelope and give that to one of the elders by next Sunday.
