## PASSOVER

While the disciples were going to and fro throughout the shops and vendors seeking the elements of the Passover Supper, Jesus might have been teaching little children the story of the first Passover. Their eyes were wide open with intensity, hanging on the Savior's every word. How would Jesus describe the last plague on Egypt? Would it have been anything like the Cecil B. DeMille epic movie?

While this is a fictionalized account it is based on elements of historical and biblical fact. The preparation of the Passover Feast was not taken lightly. It was from this feast that Jesus took two elements, unleavened bread and fruit of the vine, and utilized them in the memorial of the Lord's Supper. Many religious groups take the Lord's supper only on Easter Sunday.

"And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, blessed and broke *it*, and gave *it* to the disciples and said, "Take, eat; this is My body." Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave *it* to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins." (Matthew 26:26- 28)

So if you are reading this and not familiar with churches of Christ, we participate in the Lord's Supper every Lord's Day, Not just Easter.

## NICARAGUA MEDICAL/EVANGELISM CAMPAIGN

On June 17th, eleven Christians from Warners Chapel (David & Jeannie Moore, Ingrid Mock, Todd and Andrew Hinson, Andy & Robbie Santiago, Justin & Amber Minor, Jessica Paschal and Olivia Clemmons) will be leaving for Nicaragua on a Medical/Evangelism Campaign. The elders have set aside \$7,500 from the church treasury to help with expenses. That amounts to approximately \$682 per person. Due to rising fuel costs, the airfare this year will be \$1,012 and the in-country expense has increased to \$750. Each participant contributed \$300 as a commitment fee at the time they submitted their application. Unless other individuals contribute toward the remaining expense, each participant will be responsible for around \$800. For those of you who can't go to Nicaragua, this is an opportunity for you to participate in addition to your regular contribution. If you would like to contribute, write your check to Warners Chapel and put it in the Nicaragua envelopes you will find on the credenza in the foyer.
