## SERMON ON THE MOUNT #I

Those who heard the wonderful sermon on the mountain witnessed the greatest series of truths that has ever been presented. We are most fortunate that inspiration has given us this sermon to study and meditate upon. Beginning with this issue of the bulletin, we wish to explore some of the sublime truths presented by our Lord.

Jesus begins by presenting some of the basic characteristics that his followers must have. They are found in Matt. 5:3-12.

1- "Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." "Blessed" means "happy" or "well favored". To be "poor in spirit" means to be without the proud and haughty spirit of the world.

2- "Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted." Mourn over what? His own sins and the sins of others. No one can be pleasing to God who seems to glory in sin.

3- "Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth." The mild or gentle person is the only one who can really enjoy the things of the earth.

4- "Blessed are they that hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled." If our desire for right doing is as intense as a man who is starving or dying of thirst, that craving will be fully satisfied. Just as a starving man will not miss a meal, so a person who is hungering and thirsting after righteousness will not miss a service or an opportunity to study his Bible.

5- "Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy." If we show mercy to those who wrong us, we are promised that God will be merciful to us.

6- "Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God."

7- "Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the sons of God."

8- "Blessed are they that have been persecuted for righteousness sake:"
