If ye do these things ye shall never fall. 2nd. Peter. 1:10  
In this passage Peter has enumerated several things, that  
we as Christians must add to prevent falling. Namely, Add  
to your Faith, hence we conclude that one must have faith  
or he cannot add to it. So add to faith, (1) Virtue, this  
attribute must support the faith we possess. In this par-  
ticular sense, virtue is active quality or power. Potency.  
God's word is powerful. Romans. 1:16. We should be so filled  
with it that our faith may never be weakened. (2) Knowledge  
Most assuredly, this is knowledge of God's word. We must  
therefore study in order to acquire knowledge. Study to  
show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not  
to be ashamed rightly dividing the word of truth. 2nd. Tim  
2:15. Again, till I come again give attendance to reading.  
1st. Tim. 4:13. Peter says, desire the sincere milk of the  
word, that ye may grow thereby. 1st. Peter. 2:2. Read also  
Heb. 5:12. 2nd. Peter. 1:3. Yes, add knowledge of God's word.  
(3) We are to add Temperance. Self contrd. Moderate. Paul  
says, 1st. Cor. 9:27. But I keep under my body, and bring  
it into subjection: lest by any means, when I have preach-  
ed to others, I myself should be a castaway. Romans 8:13.  
He says, for if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but  
if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body  
ye shall live. Then again, in Colossians 3:5 he says, Mor-  
tify therefore your members which are upon the earth;  
fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil con-  
cupiscence, and covetousness, which is iddetry; for which  
things sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of  
disobedience. Yes, we must exercise self control. (4) Add  
Patience. To get the lesson, read the entire book of Job  
And also read, Jas 5:1-8. (5) Add Godliness. Grow more like  
God each day. Ye are the salt of the earth, the light of  
the world. Matt. 5:13-14. Adding Godliness. is to be Godlike

daily. Not just a one day per week proposition. God is Godly at all times. So it behooves us to be the same. (6) To Godliness, add Brotherly kindness. Read Genesis, 12:8. Here we find depicted an example that is most outstanding. Abraham's ~~the~~ great principle, while Lot has that of selfishness. Read ~~Gen.~~ Chapter, 12. Also read, 1st. John, 3:17. Read also, entire second chapter, of 1st. John. It is obvious that when we show to the world our love, one toward the other, that it tends to have great effect. (7) Last, add Charity or love. Love God, Christ and the teachings of the Holy Spirit. And as we add this characteristic it will be hard for us to absent ourselves from any service, that is possible for us to attend. Now IF you DO THESE THINGS, YE SHALL NEVER FALL. But, if we fall here the entrance to heaven shall be closed against us. Let us read, pray, and be faithful in all things.

The attendance Sunday night was gratifying. You came out in an excellent way Sunday evening. I would to God, that all had been present. Sunday evening, is a part of the Lord's day. To take that which belongs to another, is not right. Paul says, Romans. 12. I beseech you brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies as a living sacrifice. So it follows, to be a living sacrifice, is to be present, alive, show to the world the reality of religion. I trust that every member will be present the next time. I am not grumbling, I merely want to see us, do the whole of Christian living. We shall be looking for you.
