“Daily Bible ...”

It is a good thing to be a daily Bible reader. It is a great habit to establish to read a part of God’s Word every day. Do you remember what you read on Monday? (without looking it up). The point being made is this: you can read the Bible every day and not gain from it as much as you should. Two passages come to mind. One is **2 Timothy 2:15** which teaches us to not only read the Bible but study it. Then we are to give diligence to doing the things we learn from reading it. The other passage is **James 2:22** which teaches us to **“be doers of the word and not hearers only.”**

We **must** read the Bible daily but we must also put into practice what we read. Sometimes, we can just read the Bible and say we have done our duty. But to be a Christian who is growing in the faith, we **must** do more than just read. How do we do that? Brother Guy N. Woods once said that if we study the New Testament just fifteen minutes a day, in ten years we would be knowledgeable enough to not necessarily have passages memorized, but that we would have a much greater working knowledge of the New Testament. By doing that, we would be giving diligence to show ourselves approved unto God, workmen not needing to be ashamed.

Being a daily Bible reader is a good thing, but a daily Bible “doer” is even better.
