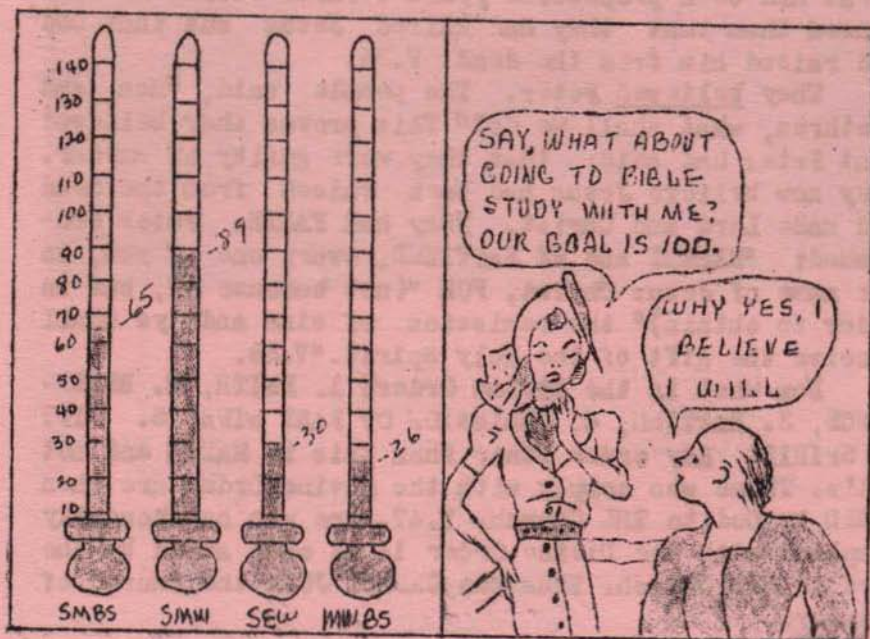
## — THIS'N THAT —

## — THE CHURCH OF CHRIST —

Last week we learned that the Kingdom of Christ or His Church was established on the day of Pentecost, A.D. 33. Thus any religious body that had its beginning before, or since that time does not belong to the Lord and He has nothing to do with it.

This week we shall notice what one has to do in order to be added to The Church. It is probable that we could find no better place to learn these requirements than the same place where we find The Church established. Acts 2.

Let us notice. The Apostles were baptized in the Holy Spirit and received power. Vv. 1-4. They received power to speak languages, vv. 6-8, which they had not learned. Though the other apostles also preached, the sermon delivered by Peter is the only one recorded. Jesus had promised Peter the "keys of the kingdom". Matt. 16:19, and now Peter, under the influence of the Holy Spirit uses those keys. He preaches a sermon—the first gospel sermon—about Jesus. He said this event had been prophesied years before. V. 16. He convinced them that they had killed Jesus but that God had raised him from the dead. V. 36.

They believed Peter. The people said, "Men and brethren, what shall we do?" This proves they believed what Peter had said: that they were guilty of murder. They now believe Jesus had been raised from the dead and made Lord and Christ. They had FAITH. Peter continued: "REPENT and BE BAPTIZED, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ, FOR "(not because of, but in order to obtain)" the remission of sins and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." V. 38.

Now what is the Divine Order? 1. FAITH, 2. REPENTANCE, 3. BAPTISM, 4. REMISSION OF PAST SINS, 5. GIFT OF SPIRIT. Any order other than this is MAN'S and not God's. Those who comply with the Divine Order are then ADDED by God to THE Church. V. 47. One who has honestly complied with the Divine Order is at once added by the Lord to HIS Church. Thus man CANNOT JOIN the Church of the Lord.
