## Restoring Our Brethren

**James 5:19–20 (NKJV)** — **19** Brethren, if anyone among you wanders from the truth, and someone turns him back, **20** let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins.

The Bible teaches, numerous times, that we have a responsibility to our brethren. Such as Romans 16:17, 1 Corinthians 5, Galatians 6:1, and 2 Thessalonians 3:6. But we do we know why we are responsible for each other? Do we understand why we are to “keep a watch” on each other? James gives us a really good insight into the answer to these questions.

The first thing that we notice is that it is a real possibility to wander from the truth. This is a truth that is mentioned throughout the rest of the scriptures as well (1 Cor. 10:1-11, 2 Peter 2:20-22, etc.). When this happens the individual is in a worse situation than they were, to begin with before they were obedient to the Gospel (2 Peter 2:20-21). Because this has happened, we need to remember that LOVE is the changing factor and command that the Lord has instructed us to show. We notice in John 13:34-35, that LOVE FOR EACH OTHER is the token or the sign of TRUE DISCIPLES of Christ. We have to see each other as, not just another person, but as a part of us individually. Paul put it this way:

**1 Corinthians 12:26 (NKJV)** — **26** And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; or if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it.

We are all members of one another and therefore what happens to one EFFECT US ALL!

With love and understanding, we should be able to see clearly why we are to do something when we see our brethren wander from the truth. We must have the heart to do whatever we can to turn that brother or sister back. We do this because of 3 things:

1. Turn the sinner from the error of his ways
2. Save his soul from death
3. Will cover a multitude of sins

Why would we NOT want to do this for our brethren? Let's notice how John puts it in 1 John 4:20-21.

**1 John 4:20–21 (NKJV) — 20** If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love God whom he has not seen? **21** And this commandment we have from Him: that he who loves God must love his brother also.

Also notice 1 John 3:17.

**1 John 3:17 (NKJV) — 17** But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him?

Our hearts should be MOVED TOWARDS helping our brethren and NEVER willing to cut them off. Our responsibility is laid in the desire to save, not only our souls but also the souls of our brothers and sisters. We must remember that we are in this same fight through life and longing to get everyone we can to Heaven. NOT JUST OURSELVES!

We desire to cover as many sins as we possibly can in both our lives and others. This phrase means that we will PREVENT sins from happening because we decided to do what's right. It is just like what James said in James 4:7-8, "Submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you." This must be the mindset of everyone in the church to strive to have this concept to not only apply to themselves but also to each member. Because REMEMBER we are ALL FAMILY!
