#### Nicaragua Mission

In three months, eleven Christians from Warners Chapel (Karen & Olivia Clemmons, Holly Hauser, Todd & Andrew Hinson, Amber Minor, Ingrid Mock, David & Jeannie Moore, and Andy & Nikki Santiago) will be leaving for Nicaragua on the annual Medical/Evangelism Campaign. This year the campaign will be held in Las Flores, Nicaragua. The group will be leaving the Warners Chapel building around 2:30am on Friday, June 15<sup>th</sup> for a 6:35am flight out of Raleigh to Miami to Managua.

The elders have set aside \$7,000 from the church treasury to help with expenses. That amounts to approximately \$636 per person. The group was able to get a special airfare of around \$570. In-country expenses will be approximately \$750. Each participant contributed \$300 as a commitment fee at the time they submitted their application. Unless other individuals contribute toward the remaining expense, each participant will be responsible for another \$400.

Money is also taken for various benevolent and special needs that arise such as purchasing rice and beans, medicine, or Bibles. For those of you who can't go, this is an opportunity for you to participate in addition to your regular contribution. If you desire to contribute, write your check to Warners Chapel and put it in the Nicaragua envelopes you'll find on the credenza in the foyer.

Our ladies are currently making dresses and stuffed bears that will be decorated by our youth. These handmade dresses and bears are always a huge hit with the Nicaraguan children. They are so proud of their new clothes and toys.

Before returning home on Sunday night the 24<sup>th</sup>, the group will have experienced the mental and physical challenges of doing mission work in a very hot, humid, and poverty stricken 3<sup>rd</sup> world country. But, it is a tremendously rewarding opportunity to affect the lives of several thousand people both physically and spiritually. Please pray for the campaign and do whatever else you can to make it a success.
