#### TEENS AND DATING - PART TWO

Anyone in his right mind knows you were born ready to date. Right? Wrong!

It sounds right, but there can be serious consequences to dating before you're ready. For example, one young girl liked a guy at school, but she knew he had some bad habits. She knew she shouldn't date him until he straightened those out. Finally, she gave in and dated him under the pretense that he would "settle down." Naively, she believed him. And kept on believing him until they got married. She was counseled to wait, but she answered, "We're in love. It will work out."

Only one month after their wedding, he resumed his old habits. But she stayed with him, hoping that he would hold to his promise and change. Then one day, to her amazement, he told her he was tired of being "tied down." He wanted his freedom.

Abruptly, divorce erased five years of marriage. She found herself responsible for two young children. Having only a high school education, she couldn't find a job to provide for them adequately.

This girl was living in an unfortunate present, facing an uncertain future, because of an irresponsible past.

She experienced the full force of The Law of the Harvest:

You reap what you sow.

You reap more than you sow.

You reap later than you sow.

She sowed an immature decision. Later, she reaped many results of that decision.

Many dating problems, as well as many marriage problems, result from one or both of the individuals starting to date before he or she is old enough. Consider this research: 91 percent of girls who began dating at age twelve had sex before graduation, compared with 56 percent who had dated at thirteen; 53 percent who dated at fourteen; 40 percent who dated at fifteen; and 20 percent who dated at sixteen. Seventy percent of boys with a ninth-grade steady said they'd had sex, compared to 60 percent of girls; 52 percent of boys who dated occasionally as freshmen had sex, compared to 35 percent of girls.

The girl in the previous example was definitely not old enough to date, because she did not have the maturity to resist her emotions and make a responsible choice.

The real answer to the right age to start dating is "H"--"none of the above." Being old enough to date is not a physical age. Instead it is an issue of maturity. It shows up in the quality of your relationship with your parents and especially in your ability to resist physical involvement consistently and completely. The statistics quoted earlier show that most students start dating long before they are ready.

Our study on happiness today comes from an Old Testament psalm. It speaks of the joy of family

Psalm 127:1: "Except the LORD build the house, they labour in vain that build it: except the LORD keep the city, the watchman waketh but in vain. 2: It is vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows: for so he giveth his beloved sleep. 3: Lo, children are an heritage of the LORD: and the fruit of the womb is his reward. 4: As arrows are in the hand of a mighty man; so are children of the youth. 5: Happy is the man that hath his quiver full of them: they shall not be ashamed, but they shall speak with the enemies in the gate."

Let's notice some important things the Lord says about happiness and the family.

- \* Family can never be what it should unless the Lord's will is being followed. Family without God and His word is vanity. That would mean that even if you have a wonderful family relationship, the ultimate goal of family (eternal life) cannot be realized. There will be no pleasant family relationships in hell no matter how wonderful it was on earth.
- \* Family is the creation of God. Of course we know that, but we sometimes may fail to be thankful for family, especially if it is grown family and we are in the midst of some squabble. Even in this life, there is a great loss of happiness when we stop seeing the good in our family.
- \* Children are a heritage from the Lord. Think about the word, heritage. Your children will be what is left of your influence in the world after you are gone. They are your legacy. All the more reason to let the Lord build the house.
- \* A man's (woman's) family can bring great joy to life when they are pointed in the right direction like an arrow flies to it target in the hand of a mighty archer.

Let's make happiness contagious to others by our own life leading the way to it.
