WILL YOU LOOK AT THAT?

For years Creation Scientists have been exploring the concept of an early earth. Many of the expressions in the fossil record were previously explained by the movement of glaciers during the "Ice Age."

After the Mount St. Helens volcanic eruption in May of 1980, scientists began to explore the site and made some breathtaking observations.

Dr. Steven A. Austin, a renowned Geologist and Creationist Scientist, has affirmed that not only at Mount St. Helens, but "All major mountains of the world have fossil of sea creatures in very widespread sedimentary strata at high elevations. Scripture describes a global flood in no uncertain terms."

Another example of a world-wide flood are tectonic changes, that is, changes in the earth's foundation plates. The remnants of these changes that occurred quickly and not in millions of years, formulate the concept of Catastrophism. Some Catastrophe must have occurred to cause these formations to move so rapidly.

Rivers, canyons, gorges, mountains contain enormous evidence of a world-wide flood. It was through great amounts of water pressure and heat that created these topographical occurrences. Mammalian fossil forms provoke an interesting look. For example there are no fossils of camels in Africa or Asia yet there are camel fossils in North America. There are no bears in Africa and no snakes in Hawaii or New Zealand.

Jesus recognized the Flood to be world-wide. "But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, And knew not until the flood came, and **took them all away**; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be." (Matthew 24:37-39)

We can find and know the truth. All we need to do is look for it.

READY OR NOT

In a cemetery in Hanover, Germany, is a grave covered with huge slabs of granite and marble, fastened with heavy steel clasps.

It belongs to a woman who did not believe in the resurrection of the dead. Yet she directed in her will that her grave be made so secure that if there were a resurrection, it could not reach her.

In time, however, a seed began to grow and push its way out from beneath the slabs. As the trunk enlarged, the stones were gradually shifted and the steel clasps were wrenched from their sockets.

The dynamic life force contained in that little seed is only a faint reflection of the tremendous power of God's creative word that someday will call to life the bodies of all who are in their graves. Willing or not, all will be resurrected (John 5:28-29). A messenger from God revealed this truth to Daniel. As this angelic messenger opened the door to the hallway of time, he revealed to the prophet many things: the rise and fall of various kingdoms, the invasion of the army from the North, and, ultimately, the resurrection of the dead. from those who are prepared—whose names are written in the Book of Life—It is a resurrection to everlasting damnation.

This Old Testament message is also echoed throughout the New Testament. The apostle Paul declared that "the dead in Christ will rise first" (1 Thessalonians 4:16), while the apostle John saw the dead, who were "judged every man according to their works" (Revelation 20:13).

There is no way you can avoid the resurrection, but you can be ready for it. Make sure that your name is written in the Book of Life. Only a fool fails to prepare for what he knows is coming. Have you believed in Christ (John 3:16), repented of your sins (Luke 13:3), confessed the name of Christ (Romans 10:9-10), and been baptized for the remission of sins? (Acts 2:38). If not, prepare for your grave to be opened one day.
