"I LOVE MY SISTER"

Vicky and I sat in the bleachers at the ice rink with ten-year-old Caleb and three-year-old Hannah. We were waiting for fifteen-year-old Lauren to come out and skate in the figure skating competition. Little Hannah was squirming and complaining while we waited. Three-year-old Hannah didn't really much like waiting for anything. But Hannah stopped wiggling and fussing as soon as Lauren skated out onto the ice. Hannah watched the smooth, fluid motions of her sister's ice-skating for a few moments and then said, "I love my sister." Hannah was happy to see her big sister skating so well. It made Hannah feel happy and proud for Lauren.

Sometimes we can learn from small children. When good things happen to a sister-in-Christ, or a brother-in-Christ we should be happy for them, and proud of them. We should rejoice when they rejoice (Romans 12:15). We are happy when something positive happens for a fellow Christian. Perhaps a new job, a raise, a new child or grand-child, or maybe just seeing a few good things happen during a time of long-term and serious illness.

Love will be the underlying cause for being happy for our brothers and sisters in Christ when good things happen to them. Paul writes, "Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection" (Colossians 3:12-14). Love is the bond that completes these characteristics and

holds them all together. Love motivates mercy, kindness, humility, longsuffering, forgiveness, etc. And, it is when we have this kind of love that we will be genuinely happy for a brother or sister in Christ when they do well.

We must not be jealous of a brother or sister when good things happen to them. Jealousy and envy are listed as works of the flesh in Galatians 5:19-21. James writes, "If you have bitter envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth. This wisdom does not descend from above, but is earthly, sensual, demonic. For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there" (James 3:14-16).

John's inspired letter to Gaius says, "Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers. For I rejoiced greatly when brethren came and testified of the truth that is in you, just as you walk in the truth. I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth" (3 John 2-4). Here we see John's desire that good things would happen to these Christians, and expressing joy in knowing of their great faithfulness. When his brothers and sisters-in-Christ did well He was happy. However, this same book speaks of someone refused to receive good brethren because he loved to have the preeminence (3 John 9-10). This man lashed out at his brethren, showing no love for them, as he tried to hurt them. This is evil. This is the opposite of the approach we should take. We want to be like John who was happy when good things happened for his brethren and not like Diotrephes who attacked his brethren.

Twelve years ago, a little three-year-old girl sat in the bleachers gleaming with pride as she watched her sister skating and said, "I love my sister." Be happy for our Christian brothers and sisters when they do well, and when good things happen to them.
