TROUBLES

"Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me." (John 14:1)

Oft this beloved and familiar quotation is used as a message of comfort and solace to those in grief, but what of the troubles both little and big which come to Christ's children daily? Literally thousands of little irritating troubles come compared with the infrequent overwhelming griefs to which this Scriptural admonition is usually applied.

The little troubles are really those which test us most. We take our big troubles to him in prayer, but ofttimes allow little troubles to completely disconcert us. Many a Christian's influence is sadly compromised by his irritability, his impatience, and his intolerance in the home and in the office. They are the "little foxes, that spoil the vineyards." (Song of Solomon 2:15)

The measure of a Christian's real character is his reaction to little troubles; for life is made up, not of great sacrifices and arduous tasks, but of little

things, in which thoughtful consideration, a sense of humor, magnanimity of spirit exemplified in forgiveness, preserve and foster the serenity of character which Jesus desired for us when He said, "Let not your heart be troubled."
