He began by speaking of those qualities in people that will cause them to be happy and blessed (Matthew 5:1-16) Those qualities include meekness, a hunger for righteousness, mercy, purity of heart, a peace-making spirit, and a willingness to shine the light of good works in our lives for the purpose of glorifying God. In the case of asking for forgiveness we confidently approach the throne of grace to obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need. We are confident of that forgiveness because of our High Priest, Jesus the Christ. It is great to be a Christian!

It's great to be Christians because God loves us (Romans 5:8). It's wonderful to be Christians because we have been justified by the blood of Jesus Christ (Romans 5:9). It's tremendous to be Christians because we have been saved from wrath (Romans 5:9). It's a joy to be Christians because we have been reconciled to God (Romans 5:10-11). It's a blessing to be Christians because we have put to death the old man of sin and we are living a new life (Romans 6). It's great to be Christians because "there is now therefore no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit (Romans 8:1-4)."
