Deacon Duty Description - Continued **Benevolence**

- Maintain list of questions for persons requesting benevolence.
- Investigate requests for benevolence to determine if legitimate.
- Maintain supply of benevolent items when appropriate.
- Make arrangements to comply with requests if legitimate and practical.
- Confer with elders as needed.

Deacon Duty Description **Baptistry Maintenance**

- Monitor baptistry conditions on a weekly basis.
- Clean baptistry and change filters as needed.
- Purchase and apply materials for purification of water.
- Make necessary repairs when capable.
- Schedule other repairs by professionals

Deacon Duty Description **Building Maintenance**

- Maintain facilities by making repairs when capable.
- Scheduling other repairs by professionals.
- Arrange to replace items when repair isn't possible or practical.
- Obtain materials as needed for use by others in making repairs or replacements.

Deacon Duty Description Filter Maintenance

- Check all heat-pump and furnace filters on a bi-monthly basis.
- Replace filters as needed.
- Purchase and stockpile filters as needed.

Deacon Duty Description Snow Removal

- Remove snow and ice from steps and walkways prior to services.
- Arrange for snow and ice removal from parking lot prior to services.
- Salt ice as needed prior to removal.
- Sweep melted snow and ice from steps and walkways as needed.
