## "Appreciation"

In his book on those who serve in the leadership of the church Franklin Camp wrote, "No men carry a heavier load than elders. Even the president of the United States does not have responsibilities as serious as those of elders. The President's responsibilities are concerned primarily with the social and economic welfare of the people. Elders are responsible for the eternal welfare of those under their oversight."

He then lists five reasons why he appreciates elders. How about you? Do you have an appreciation for elders? Do you have five reasons why you appreciate them? Let me share with you Brother Camp's list and then see if any of your reasons match his. 1) the preparation they have to make in order to qualify to serve; 2) the leadership they have shown in their families; 3) their Bible knowledge; 4) they receive less encouragement than any group of men he knew; 4) they work while others sleep; 5) they plan for the spiritual growth of the church.

Perhaps you have other reasons, and that's great. As we begin our study of this vitally important subject, please keep in mind He.13:17, "Obey them which have rule over you, and be submissive, for they watch out for your souls as those who must give account. Let them do so with joy and not with grief, for that would be unprofitable for you."

Yes, it is a serious subject indeed. We need to remember that God's Word is the final authority in these matters. That applies to all of us and not just the elders.
