On October 20th and 21st Warners Chapel will be hosting a Financial Seminar sponsored by Freed-Hardeman University. On Saturday morning there will be a ½ day seminar led by brother Kyle Lamb. Kyle is a native of Southern Indiana and graduated from Freed-Hardeman University with business finance degree in 2000 and an MBA in 2011. He is a Certified Financial Planner and has spent most of his career specializing in providing financial planning services to alumni and friends of Freed-Hardeman University. He also spent two years working as a financial advisor for a large brokerage firm. He is currently the Assistant Vice-President for Regional Development at Freed-Hardeman University, where he leads the office in structuring financial planning techniques and strategies to meet the needs and desires of donors, alumni and friends of the university.

This seminar is free and nothing is being sold. We also hope to have a financial aid representative from Freed-Hardeman to assist in how to pay for college. In the afternoon, there will be 5 one hour private counseling sessions offered to help families with their individual financial planning. A signup sheet will be placed on the bulletin board. How can we have salt in ourselves? We read in Mark 9:50, “Salt is good, but if the salt loses its flavor, how will you season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have peace with one another” (NKJV). Peace is mentioned 92 times in the New Testament. Can you have peace without being content? Think of contentment as the “Salt in yourselves.” I know a verse that gives me all the contentment and peace I need. Hebrews 13:5 reads, “Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, “I will never leave you nor forsake you” (NKJV).
