THE BIBLE AND NATIONS

Professor Alexander Tyler wrote about democracy in the Athenian pattern. As he spoke of the world's greatest civilizations he noted a sequence that they all followed. That sequence is as follows.

From bondage to spiritual faith
From spiritual faith to great courage
From courage to liberty
From liberty to abundance
From abundance to selfishness
From selfishness to complacency
From complacency to dependence
From dependence back into bondage

This pattern noted by Professor Tyler is exactly what we see in the Scriptures. The Bible is filled from cover to cover with information about God's relationship to nations. The old Testament discusses the history of various nations as they relate to God's plan to bring both His Son and the church into the world (Daniel 2, 7, etc.). The Old Testament also contains frequent reference to God's destruction of nations because of their extreme wickedness (Nahum, etc.). When we come to the New Testament we read of God's exhortation to pay our taxes and respect the government under which we live (Romans 13:1-8). To suggest that the Bible says nothing about God's relationship to nations and governments is to make clear one of two things; either the person who has made such a suggestion has never read the Bible or that person chooses to ignore what they have read.

Three points can be used to summarize what the Bible says concerning God's relationship to nations. 1. God is in control (Daniel 4:25). 2. When nations leave solid and ethical moral principles behind, God destroys them (Obadiah 1). 3. Christians must respect government and follow the law unless such law contradicts Christ's law (Romans 13:1-8; Acts 5:29).
