ARE YOU SERIOUS?

Are you serious about Christianity, or are you simply involved in playing a game of "Just in Case"? Just in case there is a God I should serve Him." "Just in case the Bible is true, I should follow it." Is that why serve God? If that is why you serve God then you are probably not very serious about Christianity.

Those who examined the evidence, and who have come to firm convictions about their faith are the ones who are serious. When we come to know there is a God, and following the Bible. When we come to know that we have salvation, we live with hope, confidence, and determination (John 8:32; I John 5:13; I John 5:19, 20).

Those who are serious about the Christian faith are those who have begun to appreciate what God has done for us. God created us, and gave us everything we need. This is our purpose (Ecclesiastes 12:13, 14).
