ARE THEY REALLY LOST?

Some congregations and some individual members behave in such a way that indicates they are not particularly concerned about saving lost souls. There may be many reasons why this is the case. Perhaps one of the reasons is because some Christians wonder if those who are not Christians are really lost. Should you have any doubt about their lost condition you have only to read the Bible. An honest examination of Scripture will lay to rest all such doubt.

The Bible clearly teaches that those who do not hear the truth will be lost. One must call on the name of the Lord to be saved (Romans 10:13). One will not have faith if he does not know what to believe (Romans 10:14-17). One will not know what to believe if he has not heard the truth (Romans 1:16).

The Bible teaches that those who do not believe will be lost (Mark 16:16). Without faith we cannot please God (Hebrews 11:6). Those who do not believe in Jesus Christ will die in their sins (John 8:24).

The Bible teaches that those who do not repent of their sins will be lost (Acts 17:30). Remission of sins is required if we are to be reconciled to God (I John 1:5-7; Isaiah 59:1, 2). There is no remission of sins without repentance (Acts 2:38).

The Bible teaches that those who do not have the courage to confess their faith in Christ will be lost (Matthew 10:32, 33). Paul said one must confess the Lord Jesus to be saved (Romans 10:9). That is why confession is made "unto salvation (Romans 10:10)." Should a person fear to confess his faith in Christ, that person will be lost.

The Bible teaches that those who are not baptized are lost (I Peter 3:21). One must be baptized to receive remission of sins (Acts 2:38). One must be baptized to have their sins washed away, Acts 22:16).

The Bible teaches that those who are baptized into Christ are added to His church (Acts 2:47; Galatians 3:27). Being baptized into a church founded by men will save no one. Being baptized into Christ and then joining a denominational church will cause one to be lost.

The Bible teaches that all who are baptized into Christ must remain faithful to Him if they are to be saved (Romans 12:1; 2; Revelation 2:10; Matthew 6:33). Those who fall away from the truth will fall away from the grace of God (Galatians 5:1-4). Those who fall from the grace of God will be lost (2 Peter 2:20-22).

The Bible teaches that all those who refuse to hear these things and obey the Lord will be lost (Matthew 7:21-27; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9). One cannot honestly read these Scriptures and come to any other conclusion. The reasonable understanding and application of the Scriptures tells us that one must be a faithful member of the church which Jesus Christ established in order to be saved. If we love the lost we will teach this message.



SAVED BY SAVING ANOTHER
