STEWARDSHIP SERIES

Our theme for 2008 is "Living For Jesus." This concept incorporates many ideas; one of which is Stewardship. The Elders and I will begin a study on Stewardship beginning the first Sunday in March and continuing through May.

A study of Stewardship concerns the facts surrounding the time and effort that we expend "living for Jesus." The God of Heaven will call us into account for all that we do in this life (cf. 2 Corinthians 5:10) and all that we do not do!

Let us compare Stewardship to Marriage. Suppose a couple plans to be married and their relationship is great up to the day of the ceremony. They go on a Honeymoon trip and everything is still great but in the weeks that follow, something changes. The husband begins exhibiting signs of apathy. It seems he wants to spend most of his time away from his wife. He goes out with his friends every night after work and plays paintball. Nearly all or his paycheck is spent buying camouflage clothing, paintballs, CO2, guns, protective gear, etc. This goes on for months and the wife is upset with her husband. They had made a commitment to each other and he has broken the commitment.

God expects us to keep our commitment with Him and He will hold us accountable. Our lives must be completely devoted to Him or He will not be pleased.

THE DESIRE TO LEARN

It has been said that when a man no longer has a desire to learn, he ceases having a purpose in life. Living the Christian life can be described in much the same way. When Christians lose their desire to learn the will of the Savior, they cease to have the purpose of pleasing God. Psalms 143:10 says, "Teach me to do thy will, for thou art my God, thy spirit is good, lead me into the land of uprightness."

Christians must desire to learn the will of God to be pleasing in his sight. God's wisdom leads us to righteousness. In Luke 24:27, Jesus taught those around him of Moses and the prophets and expounded about God's will concerning himself. The only way we can learn of God is through studying his word. In the Lord's church today, the entire Bible is taught from Genesis to Revelation so we can learn all of God's will.

Philippians 1:9 says, "And this I pray that your love may abound yet more and more, in knowledge and in all judgment." To be pleasing to God, we must learn his will. To grow as Christians, we must gain knowledge from Christian teachers, which requires us to attend classes offered by the Lord's church.

If we are present in class when the scriptures are taught, we have a better understanding of God's word and the actions we must take to be pleasing in God's sight. Col. 1:19 says, "For this cause we also since the day we heard it do not cease to pray for you and to desire that you may be filled in the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding."

Each Christian must make a decision to attend the classes set forth by the church leadership. Each one must have a desire to learn. If anyone does not have a desire to attend classes in order to help them be pleasing to God, then they have lost their purpose of pleasing God. To be Christ like, one must know Christ and live according to his will. Without knowledge of Christ, this is impossible.

Classes are taught each Sunday morning and Wednesday evening to help each of us learn the true will of God that we are to live by. Search your heart and find the purpose you have in life: either your purpose is to learn of God and please him or you have no real purpose in your Christian life. Attending Bible classes is your personal responsibility, so please make the decision to attend.
