


If a man preaches just what the apostles preached, without adding thereto, taking therefrom or in any way changing it; and if those who hear his preaching accept and conform to it, what will they be religiously?Will they be Catholics, Episcopalians, Methodists, Baptists, Presbyterians, etc.? (This is a very interesting and informative point). No one who accepted Christ under preaching of the apostles was ever recognized by any appella-tion other than just Christian. Indeed, they were continually referred to as "saints,""dis-ciples," "children of God," "members of the body of Christ;" but were never called "Cath-olics," "Episcopalians," "Methodists," "Bap-tists," "Presbyterians," etc., --only "Chris-tians." The gospel preached by Apostles does not make a man anything but a Christian.a member of the body of Christ, "which is the church." When a man becomes something more or less than just a Christian, a member of the New Testament church, he has accepted and conformed to something other than the things preached by the apostles.
