"Regardless of being famous or infamous"

Have you ever been mistaken for someone famous? I haven't either. Have you ever been mistaken for someone infamous? I haven't either. Have you ever been mistaken for someone else who was neither famous nor infamous? Now, that, I have been. I was once mistaken to have been a man with the same name and middle initial. I received a letter from his mother because the postmaster thought it was a letter to me.

Since becoming a Christian, have you ever been mistaken for **not** being one? It's not always as hard as it might sound. Sometimes it happens because we forget whose child we are. We sometimes forget we are not as young as we once were. We sometimes think we know more than God does. Sometimes we act as if we were God, assuming that our way is the only way. I have done all of those.

So how do I keep that from happening? I need to take a verse or two from the book of James. "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. For if anyone is a hearer and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was." James 1:22-24. That sets up the answer to our question by laying the groundwork for the verse that is our answer. But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, that one will be blessed in what he does." James 1:25.

I must read the Bible, I must remember what I read, and I must do the work. If I can do these things they will help me not to be mistaken for someone who isn't; regardless of being famous or infamous.
