The punishment of the wicked.

(1). Its certainty. The wicked shall be turned into hell and all the nations that forget God. Psalms 9:17. He that disbelieveth shall be damned. Mark 16:16; But the fearful, and unbelieving, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone, which is the second death. Rev. 21:8.

(2) It is not in this life. It will be after death. The rich man also died and was buried, and in hell he lifted up his eyes, being in torments. Luke 16:23. Fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul, but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. Matt 10:28. And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them; and they were judged every man according to their works. And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire. Rev. 20:12-15.

(3) It will be eternal. Depart from me ye cursed into everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels. Matt. 25:41; And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out; it is better for thee to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than having two eyes, to be cast into hell fire; where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched. Mark 9:47, 48; And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels, in flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ; who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and the glory of his power. 2nd Thess. 1:7-9.

(4). The punishment of hell will last as long as the en

joyment of heaven, And these shall go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into life eternal. Matt. 25:46. Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; 2nd Cor. 5:11; It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. Heb. 10:31; And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear. 1st Peter 4:18; So, in view of these warnings and the terrible punishment that awaits those who die out of Christ; Or, who fail to live as we should let us hearken unto the cry of the prophet Amos. Prepare to meet thy God. Amos 4:12.
