"A Look Back at the Youth Lectureship"

There are some things we can l draw from last weekend's Youth Lectureship. But before we do that there are a few "stats" to know about: 1) There was a total of 213 in attendance; 2) 80 of those were from Warners Chapel; that's 33%. Including Warners Chapel and Doug Frazier's congregation there were seventeen congregations represented. Those congregations are: Warner's Chapel, Alachua (Doug Frazier), Brewer Road, Capernaum, Cary, Cherokee, Deep River, Friendly Avenue, Gold Hill Road, Harris Boulevard, Highland Acres, Lexington, Mountain Island, North Main (Mocksville), Oak Forest, Sanford, South Fork.

Although not the only factor involved in their conversion, two young souls were added to the Lord's body on Sunday. One was early Sunday morning and the other was Sunday after the congregational dinner. We were blessed with a third baptism Wednesday evening and although the lectureship did not necessarily impact that conversion I believe it created an atmosphere that would encourage one to follow his conviction.

Because this was an idea, a lectureship, that hadn't been utilized before, there was a certain amount of "risk" involved. The idea came from within our own youth group but would the youth in other congregations respond positively to it? One hundred and thirty people and sixteen congregations is the answer. This also tells us that our youth are being led in the right direction, thinking in a spiritual direction.

But we're not finished yet. Think about how many people cooperated and worked to make this effort a success. Sleep accommodations, transportation, food, décor, attendance, clean-up, and Christian hospitality were in abundance. We also need to remember the efforts of the speakers and their willingness to participate in this activity at Warners Chapel. Looking back cause me to look forward with the hope that we have another youth lectureship.
