# **Have You Been Born Again?** (Part 2)

### The "Old Man" Dies, The "New Man" Lives

As a child growing up in West Virginia, **I was always intrigued by various** forms of life. One of the most interesting to me was the butterfly. To see the tiny egg, then the larva come forth from the egg and begin to eat and grow, the larva then become a chrysalis with seemingly no life in it, then one day the bursting of the "shell" and the springing forth of the full-grown butterfly was so exciting! The **different** "**life stages**" (**I learned later**) was called \*metamorphosis\*. 'One life-form "dies" so that the life continues in another form. And that is how Paul describes conversion: \*And you did he make alive, when ye were dead through your trespasses and sin's" (Eph. 2:1).

Because we have been born again, there is a new life that results in this transformation. It is a different kind of life. If ye died with Christ from the rudiments of the world... If then ye were raised together with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is... Put to death your members which are upon the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire... Lie not one to another; seeing that ye have put off the old man with his doings, and have put on the new man, that is being renewed unto knowledge after the image of him that created him"(Col. 2:20; 3:1,5,9-10). Before we become Christians we are the old man, but in surrendering to Christ we put on the new man. This is done when we "present our bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God" and are transformed by the renewing of the mind" (Rom. 12:1-2). Interestingly, the word which is translated transformed" is the Greek word, thetarnorphosthe. Being born again means death to the bld man" and life for the hew man. "And that is metamorphosis! It was this experience that caused Paul to write, "7 have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I that live, but Christ liveth in me: and that life which I now live in the flesh I live in faith, the faith which is in the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself up for me" (Gal. 2:20). Only the kind of change that causes one to turn his back on the former life to devote himself completely to Jesus Christ can properly be called the new birth."

## **ELDERS CORNER:**

### Nicaragua Mission 2013

Planning is already underway for the mission trip to Nicaragua this June. This year we are blessed to have the biggest turnout yet for any mission trip this congregation has been involved with. If all goes as planned, twelve from Warners Chapel (Karen & Olivia Clemmons, Catherine Cravy, Todd Hinson, Ingrid Mock, David & Jeannie Moore, Mark, Tammy, Tara and Tristan Roy and Andy Santiago) will be leaving on June 14<sup>th</sup> for Managua, Nicaragua on the annual Medical/Evangelism Campaign. This year the campaign will be held in Rama, Nicaragua, which is about a 6-hour bus ride (we're talking 70's era school buses...not air conditioned coach lines) from Managua. There are two small towns between Managua and Rama and only one place that can accommodate a pit stop for a group of 60-70 people.

Rama is literally at the end of the road on the Northeast side of Nicaragua. There are no roads beyond that point and to go further east generally requires a boat. The hotel situation will also be different this year. Only about half of the rooms have air conditioning and the remainder has fans. We have reserved a gym that will hold the entire medical clinic and it, the church building, the hotel and the restaurant where we hope to eat are all within 4 blocks of one another so we won't have an hour plus drive each way to get to the work site each day like we normally do. This will be a totally different experience this year.

The elders have set aside \$3,000 from the treasury to purchase the rice and beans that are handed out during the week. They have also allocated \$7,000 from the treasury to go toward the travel expense. The estimated total cost per person will be around \$1400. With such a large group from Warners Chapel participating, each person will have about \$580 provided from the treasury. Each participant contributed \$300 as a commitment fee at the time they submitted their application. Thus, each person will need to come up with an additional \$520 or a total of about \$6,200 for the whole team.

If you would like to assist in offsetting this expense for the participants please make your check out to Warners Chapel and use the envelopes labeled Nicaragua that you'll find on the desk in the foyer.

Money is also taken for various benevolent and special needs that arise such as purchasing medicine, Bibles or other items that directly help the church or the people in the area. For those of you who can't go, this is an opportunity for you to participate in addition to your regular contribution. Our ladies are currently making dresses for the little girls and those are always popular.

It will not be an easy week facing the physical challenges of extreme heat and humidity and the emotional challenges of working in the 2<sup>nd</sup> poorest country in the Western hemisphere. But, it is a spiritually uplifting trip where likely over 2,000 people will be helped with their medical and spiritual needs. Please pray for the campaign and do whatever else you can to make it a success.

**Sydney Marino,** the daughter of NCSHP Trooper Marino has been diagnosed with Leukemia.


