#### "WHAT DO YOU BRING?"

The book of Leviticus contains regulations for the priests and the sacrifices offered under the Law of Moses. The "peace offering" was one of many. But it was one in which God, the priests, and those who offered the sacrifice were tied more closely together. Part of the animal was burned, which was offered to God. Part of it was given to the priest (7:31, 34) to eat. The third part was given back to the one bringing the offering. This last part was to be eaten by the family and guests of the one bringing the sacrifice (7:15, 17).

The burnt offering, sin offering and meal offering primarily dealt with the forgiveness of sins. This sacrifice emphasized reconciliation, communion and agreement. It was a token of friendship between God and the offerer. It signified prosperity and happiness. The peace offering was for the purpose of showing one was reconciled with God and could enjoy fellowship with God. It was meant to be a festive and joyful occasion. Thus the peace offering was a vital part of the worship activities during the Mosaic Age.

In the Christian Age, Christians are to offer their bodies as a living sacrifice, (Rom.12:1) to God. When we come together to worship we need to have offered ourselves properly to God so that we can commune with Him and have proper fellowship with Him, (Heb.10:24-25). That means we must prepare the week **before** to be acceptable to God as we offer our worship to God.

While no longer under the Law of Moses (Col.2:14), we must still offer worship that requires us to bring to God the sacrifices He has asked for. Having done so, we can commune with Him and offer our worship. When offering God acceptable worship for that time, the Israelites brought the proper sacrifices for their worship. What do you bring?
