ELDER'S CORNER:

GRUDGE HOLDING HURTS YOURSELF

Do you still have old copies of the Reader's Digest around the house? There's lots of good material in that circular. Like this little tidbit from E. Stanley Jones:

A rattlesnake, if cornered, will sometimes become so angry it will bite itself. That is exactly what the harboring of hate and resentment against others is--a biting of oneself. We think that we are harming others in holding these spites and hates, but the deeper harm is to ourselves.

Has anyone ever held a grudge toward you? Have you ever held a grudge yourself?

The thing about holding on to a grudge is that it doesn't matter how long you have it, that feeling on the inside of hurt and resentment, anger and rage, just never totally goes away. It never goes away, that is, unless you deal with it.

Now I'm not so naive as to think that some grudges will ever be reconciled. Why? Because it takes two people to hold a grudge--the offender and the offended. When the offender tries to reconcile and the offended refuses to listen to reason and let go of the offense, the issue will never be resolved.

People, "stop the insanity!" Life is too short to harbor resentment and ill will.

If you are holding a grudge toward a brother or sister in Christ, quit! If he has tried to talk to you about it, and if the offense was sin and he's repented, let it go! If you're harboring a grudge toward someone and he has no idea of the offense, tell him. Most folks have good and honest hearts and will make restitution if they but know.

When Peter asked Jesus the question about forgiving a brother, he said, "... how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times?" Jesus responded with "... I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven" (Mt. 18:21-22).

Grudge holding enslaves both parties. Why not remove the shackles of guilt? Let go and love one another. It would be a sad day indeed if heaven passed you by.
