NCSBS UPDATE

I am very excited about the NCSBS. Four churches are partnering with us in the satellite school program beginning with the Fall Quarter, 2009. The Rutherford church in Spindale, the Mountain Island church [Formerly Westside] in Charlotte, the Raleigh church and the Oak Forest Road church in Goldsboro, have committed to our effort. This will be a tremendous boost to our "footprint" in North Carolina. These churches will serve to extend our "beacon" in various areas of the state.

Let me point out that we will have schools in the three largest population centers available. These points will establish a "feeder" system. It is our thought that, some who begin taking these part-time classes, will want to attend full-time and will then come to us to finish their training.

The Elders in these churches are excited about our school and want to be a part of it. They have also recognized that the school can be an outreach to the community. Some plan to use their local newspaper to advertise their school. Our vision for the school seems to be expanding and will soon cross state lines. It is my goal to have at least two schools in South Carolina and one in Virginia by the Fall Ouarter, 2010.
