Are You Convicted?

Faith in God, conviction, should be the foundation upon which our lives are based. One of my favorite writers, C. S. Lewis, illustrated this thought in his book *Mere Christianity*. He said, “I believe in Christianity as I believe that the sun has risen: not only because I see it, but because by it I see everything else.” Conviction in Christ shouldn’t just be a belief you hold, but the essence and heart of your existence. It should define every aspect of your life.

So back to that simple question: Is it still so simple? Are you convicted? Is your conviction your own? Why are you convicted? Can you prove your convictions? What will your conviction compel you to do? Will you share your conviction? Are you convicted enough to stay faithful no matter what? Is your conviction going to take you to Heaven?

If we were truly convicted as we should be, our life would be “about our Father’s business” as it was for Christ (Luke 2:49). If we were truly convicted, the truth and necessity of the Gospel would be bursting out of us to every lost soul with the knowledge of the fate that awaits them otherwise because of compassion in our hearts that wants Heaven for each soul and won’t accept anything else.

Conviction is an unparalleled trust in a merciful Father, an unwavering faith in His Son, an unconditional love for all His children. It demands your all. It is your all.
