ELDERS CORNER:

"A Little Math Test"

Below is a list of numbers. Cover all the numbers with a card or your hand. Slip the cover down until only the first number shows, Say it out loud. Move the card down to reveal the second number. Add it to your previous number and then say the new total out loud. Continue to the end, each time exposing one number and adding it to the previous total. Be sure to say each new total out loud.

What total did you get? Unless you are very unusual, you came up with 5000. The correct answer is 4100, but for some reason, when you get 4060 and add 40 to it, it comes out 5000.

This just shows how easy it is to miscalculate. We sometimes add just as poorly in religious matters. For instance, some think that their good works will **add up** to an eternal home. One cannot be saved by his own goodness, he must be saved by the grace of God (Ephesians 2; Titus 2:11-14)

Others take John 3:16, Acts 16:31, and other references that mention faith and then they **add** them together to **equal** "salvation" as a total. But the Bible just doesn't **add** up that way. Jesus said that man must live by "every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God" (Matthew 4:4). The Book says that in **addition** to having faith, we must have penitence, confession, and baptism (Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38; 22:16; Galatians 3:26-27).

As far as this world is concerned, we might get by without being great mathematicians, but our eternal destiny depends on whether we learn to accept all of God's revelation.

Let's not **add** to that word, or **subtract** from it in any way (Revelation 22:18-19). Let us not **divide** our allegiance between God and the world. Let us instead manifest a **simple interest** in doing what God says do in the way He said to do it (Matthew 7:21, Hebrews 5:9).
