CLOTHES TO SPRING HILL

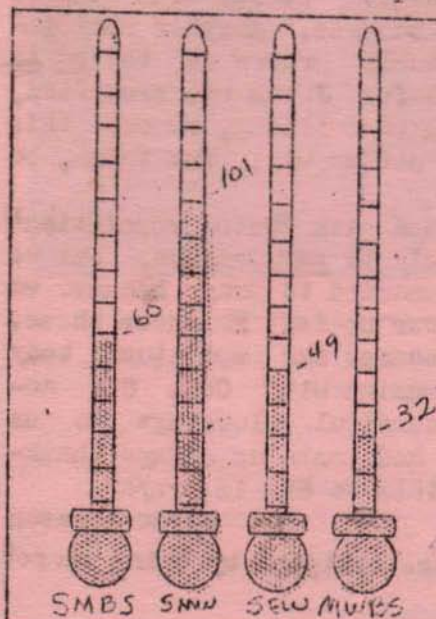

ACCEPTABLE PRAYER

There are many conditions of acceptable prayer. First of all, prayer must be offered in faith. "But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed." Jas. 1:6. We should have confidence in Him and earnestly believe that He hears us. John 5: 14-15. Acts 8:22 teaches us that our prayer should be offered in penitence. "Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee." Furthermore, we learn in Luke 18:1-14 the importance of praying in humility and reverence. The prayer that is recorded in Psm. 8 surely teaches us to be reverent and humble. We should feel a closeness to God and feel that we can speak to Him anytime, anywhere, but even with that close relationship, we should not fail to realize that He is God; He is our maker, over and above all creatures of the earth. There should be a spirit of forgiveness in our prayers. "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." Another very important condition of acceptable prayer is to be in resignation to God's will. Before Jesus was crucified, He prayed, "Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless, not my will, but thine, be done".

Our Father is not pleased with "vain repetition" in prayer. We are not merely to say prayers, but we are to pray. We are not commanded to pray because we need to acquaint God with our needs. He knows these. We are commanded to pray because our spiritual body needs to be in constant communion with God. Our dependence upon God and His bountiful blessings to us should deepen our gratitude and make us always thankful and always desiring to talk to Him in prayer.
