Top Seven Reasons to be Baptized

In previous bulletins, we published the top ten reasons why you are important, the top nine reasons to love people, and the top eight reasons to want to go to heaven.

Below are the top seven reasons to be baptized:

1. Baptism is a command from God

"And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord" (Acts 10:48).

2. Baptism is for the remission of sins.

"Then Peter said to them, 'Repent and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit'" (Acts 2:38).

3. Baptism is when we are washed by the blood of Jesus.
“ ‘And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord’ ” (Acts 22:16).
4. Baptism is a representation of the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus.
“Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall be in the likeness of His resurrection” (Romans 6:3-5).
5. Baptism is said to “save us”.
“There is also an antitype which now saves us - baptism (not removal of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God), through the resurrection of Jesus Christ” (1 Peter 3:21).
6. Baptism accompanies Faith for salvation.
“He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned” (March 16:16).
7. Baptism is necessary to be in Christ.
“For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ”
(Galatians 3:27).
