YOUR FATHER IS RICH

The Almighty, Sovereign, Self-Existent, Creator, and God is your Father if you are a Christian. Christians are those who have been born again into God's family (John 3:3-5). Christians are those who have been adopted into God's family. Paul spoke of Christians being sons of God, children of God, those who have received the Spirit of adoption, and therefore those who are heirs of God with Christ (Romans 8:13-17). If you are a Christian, God is your Father. God the Father is rich. This is why you have such a wonderful inheritance waiting for you (Romans 8:17; 1 Peter 1:3-9). Indeed, your Father is very rich, but in what ways?

Your Father is rich in grace. One cannot truly begin to even come close to expressing full appreciation for the grace of God. The New Testament book of Ephesians tells us that we have the forgiveness of sins through the blood of Jesus, according to the riches of the grace of God (Ephesians 1:7). The expression, "riches of His grace," indicates God has an abundance of grace.

Your Father is rich in mercy. Paul tells us we can be saved by the grace of God because God is rich in mercy (Ephesians 2:4). God's wealth and abundance of mercy coincide with the riches of His grace. God shows mercy to those who will humble themselves before Him.

Your Father is rich in goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering (Romans 2:4). Paul was encouraging religious hypocrites to repent and turn back to God when he spoke of God being rich in goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering. In fact, Paul makes the point that "the goodness of God leads you to repentance."

Your Father is rich in wisdom and knowledge (Romans 11:33). God is unlimited in wisdom and knowledge. After all He is the creator of all matter, energy, and life (Genesis 1). We should want to humbly submit to His will, because he is the Creator and because He is rich in wisdom and knowledge.

Because your Father in heaven is rich in grace, mercy, goodness, forbearance, longsuffering, wisdom, and knowledge He has made it possible for you and me to be saved.

where else are His riches more evident than in the sacrificial crucifixion of the Divine Son of God? It is because Jesus died we can be justified by faith (Romans 5:1). It is because Jesus died we can have peace with God (Romans 5:1). It is because Jesus gave His saving blood that we can stand in grace and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God (Romans 5:2). Through the death of Jesus, we can be justified by His blood, saved from His wrath, reconciled to God, and saved by His life (Romans 5:8-11). This salvation that produces rejoicing within is possible because your Heavenly Father is rich.

Your Father is rich in grace, mercy, goodness, forbearance, longsuffering, wisdom, and knowledge. You and I can be saved from the eternal consequences of sin, and saved to a glorious existence in heaven with God because God is rich. The riches of the Father can bring you into His family, and the riches of the Father can provide mercy to you even after you have been baptized into His family (Galatians 3:26-27).

Those who are in God's family continue to receive grace and mercy as they come before the throne of grace in prayer expressing their desire for forgiveness. God says, "Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need (Hebrews 4:16)." John writes, "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9)." John also states, "My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous (1John 2:1)."

Your heavenly Father is most certainly rich toward you. Now you must live your life in such a way that shows you are rich toward Him (1 Timothy 6:18).
