"SEVEN HABITS OF HIGHLY EFFECTIVE CHRISTIANS"

"The Seven Habits of Highly Effective People, first published in 1989, is a self-help book written by Stephen R. Covey. It has sold over 15 million copies in 38 languages since first publication which was marked by the release of a 15th anniversary edition in 2004. Covey presents an approach to being effective in attaining goals by aligning oneself to what he calls "true north" principles of a character ethic that he presents as universal and timeless." I know others have had a similar idea about using the title of this "best seller." An article along these lines might have even appeared in this publication. I wrote the following article for a congregation bulletin in West Virginia in November, 1995. "Perhaps you've seen a book with a similar title in the bookstores. The idea is to give people insight into how to live more successfully than they have been. If you, as a Christian, have reached your peak in successful Christian living, this article is not for you. If you think you have some room to improve, then please read on.

- **Habit** #1 LIVE and WORK to reach others each day as if you knew the world would end next Sunday night. THINK of that energy and the urgency!
- **Habit #2** BE AS ENTHUSIASTIC about the church and its services as if there were an overflow crowd each time. THINK of the interest, anticipation, and excitement of an overflow crowd!
- **Habit** #3 COUNT YOUR BLESSINGS by making a list of the things you are thankful to God for. THANK Him for them one by one as you offer Him your prayers!
- **HABIT #4** MAKE AND MAINTAIN A LIST OF YOUR FAULTS and pray for forgiveness and help to overcome them. THINK how much better life will be!

Habit #5 - READ YOUR BIBLE AND MEDITATE on what you read. Set Aside thirty minutes every day to spend with God in prayer, Bible study and meditation. THINK how comforting it will be to spend time with the One who loves you more than anyone else in the world!

Habit #6 - VISIT SOMEONE EACH WEEK. Visit some member you don't know very well, or someone who is sick, or someone who visited worship services, or a member who needs encouragement, or a prospective Christian. THINK of how much closer you can be with other Christians and how the church will grow!

Habit #7 - REACH ANOTHER PERSON. Conduct a Bible study in your home and invite your relatives and neighbors. The elders and the preacher will help you. THINK how you would grow!

I'm sure others could think of different habits to add to this list. Hopefully, these will help ;you not only to "say" but to "do" those things that will make you a more highly effective Christian.

NICARAGUA MEDICAL/EVANGELISM CAMPAIGN

On June 17th, eleven Christians from Warners Chapel (David & Jeannie Moore, Ingrid Mock, Todd and Andrew Hinson, Andy & Robbie Santiago, Justin & Amber Minor, Jessica Paschal and Olivia Clemmons) will be leaving for Nicaragua on a Medical/Evangelism Campaign. The elders have set aside \$7,500 from the church treasury to help with expenses. That amounts to approximately \$682 per person. Due to rising fuel costs, the airfare this year will be \$1,012 and the in-country expense has increased to \$750. Each participant contributed \$300 as a commitment fee at the time they submitted their application. Unless other individuals contribute toward the remaining expense, each participant will be responsible for around \$800. For those of you who can't go to Nicaragua, this is an opportunity for you to participate in addition to your regular contribution. If you would like to contribute, write your check to Warners Chapel and put it in the Nicaragua envelopes you will find on the credenza in the foyer.
